Cookies

Policy regarding cookies

This cookie policy applies to all websites and applications for mobile devices, which visit the manufakturechnologiczna.pl site. By using the above sites, you agree to use of cookies in accordance with this Cookies Policy. If you do not agree to our use of cookies, you should change settings of your browser in a suitable manner or resign to use the above-mentioned websites.

What are the cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are saved and stored by the browser on your computer, tablet or smartphone while you visit different websites on the internet. The cookie usually contains the name of the website from which it comes, the "life expectancy" of cookie (that is, the time of its existence), and a randomly generated unique number used to identify the browser used for connection with the website.

What do we use cookies for?

We use cookies for various purposes:

- for websites to be faster and easier to use,
- to better match the content and ads available on the Sites to your expectations and interests,
- for collect of anonymous, aggregated statistics that allow us to understand how people use our sites and help in improving their functionality and content.

Using cookies in the manner described above, we never identify our users identity based on information stored in cookies.

How long are the data in cookies stored?

Two types of cookies can be used on the websites - session and persistent. The first ones remain on your device only when using websites. Persistent cookies remain on your device for as long as they have a set lifetime or until you delete them.

Types of cookies used on the websites:

1. the "necessary" cookies, enabling the use of services available on the Website, e.g. authentication cookies used for services that require authentication on the Website,
2. cookies files used to ensure security, e.g. used to detect a fraud in the field of authentication on the Website;
3. "performance" cookies, enabling the collection of information on the use of Website pages;

4. "functional" cookies, allowing "remembering" the settings selected by the User and personalizing the User's interface, e.g. in the scope of the selected language or region of the User, font size, website appearance, etc .;
5. "advertising" cookies, enabling users to provide advertising content more tailored to their interests.

How to control and delete cookies?

The User may grant or refuse to grant permission to the installation and use of cookie files through the settings of his web browser. Failure to change the settings of the web browser settings to block cookies is synonymous with consent, which means that cookies will be stored on the User's end device. Blocking the possibility of saving cookie files may cause difficulties or lack of functionality of some Website functions. If you want to limit or block cookies, you can do so using the browser settings on your computer. The "Help" section in the browser best describes how to disable and delete cookies.
